Reach Mallorca School - Information

We're so excited about your interest in our Reach Mallorca School (RMS). This Information sheet contains further useful information about our school. If you still have unanswered questions, please feel free to contact us: school@reachmallorca.com

<u>1. Basic information</u>

The Reach Mallorca School will take place from 1 April 2023 to 27 August 2023. The total price for the school (as of 7.2022) is 5900 euros, whatever your country of origin. The mission school is aimed at young people between the ages of 18 and 35, and you must be at least 18 years of age to attend.

The school is held in English and German, so you will need to be able to speak one of these two languages.

2. Finances

The RMS costs \in 1180 per month (as of July 2022) or a total of \in 5900 for the full five months. These costs include food, accommodation, transport, travelling around the island and tuition fees. Students must cover all travel costs for journeys to and from Mallorca. A deposit of \in 900 is due before the start of school (by 17.3.2023 at the latest). Monthly costs will be reduced accordingly to \in 1000. You can pay this amount as a lump sum or in monthly instalments. We will arrange a payment plan with you once we have confirmed your enrolment at the school. If your financial situation changes during the school year, please let us know in advance. In addition to your school fees, you should allow around \in 100 for books and a monthly personal allowance for the whole year.

3. Accommodation and meals

During the school period, you and other students will live together in the same place. This might be a large house (finca or similar) or several smaller flats, where you will share a room with other students of the same sex. Meals will also usually be eaten together and prepared by the students and/or helpers. All board and lodging expenses are included in the school costs for the entire five-month period.

4. Insurance/health insurance

Students will need to take out insurance for the five-month school period. Please make sure that you have health insurance that also covers you abroad.



5. School language

As we are expecting international students, our school programme will most probably be run in English. Some lessons will be held in German and translated into English. If necessary and possible, mentoring talks can also be held in German. Speaking and understanding English is thus a requirement for attending the RMS.

6. Arrangements for married couples and families

It is possible to attend the school as a married couple or young family. However, both parties should know that they will most probably be unable to live in shared accommodation and will have to find their own accommodation nearby. In such a case, the school fees will be adjusted accordingly. The specific amount will be determined on a case-by-case basis with the persons concerned. Both married couples and families should also be aware that the five-month mission school requires a lot of focus on the school and fellowship among the students and this affects married and family life. Specific needs can, of course, be discussed in person and special arrangements be made where necessary. We are strong advocates of married and family life and realise that other arrangements may be necessary during these stages of life.

7. Special COVID requirements

Changes and adjustments to the planned school programme may be made if another wave of COVID or other global crises with corresponding measures and effects occur. However, these have to be decided on a case-by-case basis and their goal is to always ensure that the RMS can be run as normally as possible until the end of the programme.
