

Reach Mallorca School - Information

We're so excited about your interest in our Reach Mallorca School (RMS). This Information sheet contains further useful information about our school. If you still have unanswered questions, please feel free to contact us: school@reachmallorca.com

1. Basic information

The mission school is aimed at young people between the ages of 18 and 35, and you must be at least 18 years of age to attend.

Classes at the school will be mainly in English, so it is important that you can speak and understand the language well.

2. Finances

Students must cover all travel costs for journeys to and from Mallorca. A deposit of € 900 is due before the start of school (2 weeks before school start at the latest). You can pay this amount as a lump sum or in monthly installments. We will arrange a payment plan with you once we have confirmed your enrolment at the school. If your financial situation changes during the school year, please let us know in advance. In addition to your school fees, you should allow around € 100 for books and a monthly personal allowance for the whole year.

If finances are an issue, then get in contact with us and we find a solution together.

3. Accommodation and meals

You will live in a house with the students and RMS staff for the entire duration of the school. In any case, you will share your room with students of the same sex. Meals are usually eaten together and prepared by the participants and/or staff or helpers. The costs for meals are therefore covered by the school contribution that you have to pay.

4. Insurance/health insurance

Students will need to take out insurance for the five-month school period. Please make sure that you have health insurance that also covers you abroad.

5. School language

As we are expecting international students, our school programme will most probably be run in English. Some lessons will be held in German and translated into English. If necessary and possible, mentoring talks can also be held in German. Speaking and understanding English is thus a requirement for attending the RMS.

6. Arrangements for married couples and families

It is possible to attend the school as a married couple or young family. However, both parties should know that they will most probably be unable to live in shared accommodation and will have to find their own accommodation nearby. In such a case, the school fees will be adjusted accordingly. The specific amount will be determined on a case-by-case basis with the persons concerned. Both married couples and families should also be aware that the five-month mission school requires a lot of focus on the school and fellowship among the students and this affects married and family life. Specific needs can, of course, be discussed in person and special arrangements be made where necessary. We are strong advocates of married and family life and realise that other arrangements may be necessary during these stages of life.
