GOOD TO KNOW

In the following paragraphs we would like to explain our weekly and daily activities. Don't worry, it looks more than it is in the end, and we will explain them to you at the beginning of the Reach Mallorca School.

Daily routine

In order to keep the house clean and maintained, the “Daily routine” includes that each of us takes on a small cleaning task every day.

Outreaches

During the teaching phase, there will be two outreaches per week—prayer outreaches and evangelism outreaches. Together, we will pray in the specific places on Mallorca, pray with people, and share the message of Jesus. In the outreach phase, we will be out in the field every day and find creatively ways to start conversations about the Gospel and look for opportunities to encourage others.


Working-afternoon

One afternoon in a week we come together as a whole team for working-afternoon to work on bigger projects on the premises of the finca. We welcome your own ideas and suggestions to make this place more beautiful, colourful and practical.



Worship & Intercession

Worship and intercession is our first priority and therefore we want to start every day with it.




Each day will focus on a different theme of prayer and intercession, such as praying for the island, praying for nations, or simply worshiping and being in God's presence. These times are set aside to help you connect deeply with God and align your heart with His purposes. You will have the opportunity to intercede for others and see how prayer can impact lives and situations.




Free days and planned trips

Every week you will have one free day to spend. During this time there will be also staff at the Finca called weekend warrior. You are free to choose whether to come on a trip with the weekend warrior and be in community or whether you would rather take time for yourself. On Sundays we want to go all together to the churches on the island according to our vision to serve and get know the different churches. Before and after that you have also free time to spend.



Boon tasks

Every week we have scheduled trainings where we would like to do small workshops with you.



For that you can choose different kinds of Groups to learn more in social media, worship or event planing. Beyond that, you can express yourself creatively in it.




Small groups

In weekly small groups made up exclusively of students, you will have a safe space to ask and answer honest questions and share openly. These times help uncover lies, experience freedom, and invite the light of Jesus into your life.




Reach out service

Once a week, in addition to our morning "Worship & prayer", we want to come together and focus on God's voice at our evening services. We encourage you to be actively involved and to contribute on these evenings in preparation, set-up, decoration, input, music or clean-up. We look forward to execute this evening together with you and later invite other people on the island to join us.




Free time and study time

We want you to be supported in the best possible way during this special time and have therefore put a lot of thought into the curriculum and times around it. However, we don't want you to feel overwhelmed, because we are aware that this time will be very busy. Therefore, we want to give you the freedom to choose when you do your study tasks. In the weekly schedule you will find small sections without any appointments between the other appointments. These are times where you can freely decide if you need to rest or if you want to work on your study tasks. It is important to take care of each other. Therefore, if your fellow students are doing their personal study time, we would like to ask you to respect this and move conversations and louder activities to another room.



Mentoring

It is important to us that you have your personal mentor within the leader team, in order to share your heart, problems and challenges. Your mentor will support you in prayer and with advice on how to respond and act.






Daily teachings


There are daily teachings on various topics such as the Bible, the Holy Spirit, spiritual warfare, etc. The sessions are designed to help you grow spiritually and develop a strong foundation.

You not only receive knowledge but are also guided in how to apply what you learn in your daily life. This time is meant to equip and strengthen you in your personal walk with God. You also have space to learn, reflect, and go deeper into the subjects that are important for your spiritual development.



Devotional time

You will have one hour of dedicated devotional time with God each day. This time is intentionally set aside to help you build an intimate and personal relationship with Him. In this space, you will learn to recognize His voice more clearly and grow in your awareness of His presence. It is also a time to intercede in prayer—both for your own life and for others. Over time, this daily rhythm is meant to become a natural and life-giving habit that will accompany you throughout your life.



Reflection

For your time at the Reach Mallorca School you will receive a journal in which you can answer weekly reflection questions. These questions are designed to help you thoughtfully review and process your experiences. Taking the time to reflect allows you to better understand what God is teaching you each week. You will also discuss your insights with your mentor, gaining guidance and encouragement.
